### WHERE?

The MalaMala Game Reserve, Greater Kruger National Park, Mpumalanga

### WHY MALAMALA?

- Best game viewing in Southern Africa
- Largest area of private land adjoining Kruger National Park - 33,000 acres / 13 500 ha
- 19 km / 12 miles of unfenced border with Kruger National Park
- Uninterrupted flow of Sand River through property attracts game
- Longest stretch of Sand River of any surrounding properties
- Camps built on western side of Sand River for unhindered game movement into MalaMala
- Most guides have University degrees in the sciences
- Vast diversity of habitat types in MalaMala
- Opened in 1964 - one of the first tracts of private land to switch from hunting
- Excellent environment management for 50 years by Michael Rattray – a member of the National Parks Board for decades & acknowledged with a host of eco-awards
- Excellent value for money
